Romanian soprano Lorena Puican has been featured in concerts at St. Gallen's Dome and Wattwil in Switzerland, in Baden, Austria, at the Romanian National Opera Cluj, with the Cluj-Napoca Philharmonic Orchestra, and with the Orchestra of the Hungarian Opera Cluj. In 2017, she was awarded the "Feminine Creation Prize" at the Iași Opera Festival. The following year, she performed the female lead role in Romanian composer Gherase Dendrino's operetta *Lăsați-mă să cânt*, and as La Ciesca in Gianni Schicchi at the Romanian National Opera Cluj. In 2019, she sang at the company's Opera Ball and was recipient of the Alexandru Fărcaș Prize.

At 25 years old, Ms. Puican made her debut at the Romanian National Opera Cluj in the role of Mimi in *La bohème*. Following this celebrated debut, the young soprano was engaged for the company's 2019 season to debut the roles of Donna Elvira in *Don Giovanni* and Rosalinda in *Die Fledermaus*.

Ms. Puican completed her master's degree in 2019 at the conservatory in Cluj-Napoca. During her studies, she received many scholarships including the 2018 International Summer Academy scholarship from the Universität für Musik und Darstellende Kunst in Vienna.
